As of today, the distribution policy for SIP and its components changes slightly.

This is largely because, and under some pressure from users, the old fashioned installation technique using 'Microsoft Package and Deployment' is discontinued. The FSP (Freeware Service Pack) method as also discontinued.

This has been replaced by 'Advanced Installer' which makes a single MSI module. The module is called [SipInstall.msi](#) and it contains the entire SIP freeware. Remember that you need at least one SIP license to enable the freeware tools.

Download [SipInstall.msi](#) from www.dekloe.be.

Existing customers who want to upgrade their SIP are advised to do the upgrade in the following order:

1. Save the modules of you current SIP which contain the license keys. The list is on the bottom. You may already have stored them in a safe place for later use.
2. Uninstall SIP. Some of the files in the folder where you had SIP will stay there – just leave them.
3. Install the new SIP by running the downloaded [SipInstall.msi](#) to the same folder as where you had the previous version.
4. Then download the SIP product(s) for which you have a license. Note that all licensed products except SipXML2Score were upgraded today.
5. Assure that you have the license key files for the licensed SIP products in the same folder.

List of license key files:

SipSplit	SipSpli5.exe
SipXref	SipXref5.exe
SipText	SipText5.exe
SipEPS01	SipEps5.exe
SipSib	SipSib5.exe <i>and</i> SipSib50.exe
SipXML2Score	SipXML05.exe
SipScore2XML	SipXMS05.exe

One advantage for future upgrades is that you do no longer have to uninstall.
